Interesting fact about Sri Niwas Ramanujan

Mathematician Ramanujan didn't have any close friends and when someone asked him the reason he replied that nobody was up to his expectation.

When asked how he expected his friends to be, he replied like numbers 220 and 284.

The person got confused and asked, what is the connection between friendship and these numbers?

Ramanujan asked him to find the divisors of each number.

With much difficulty the person derived and listed them as

220 - 1, 2, 4, 5, 10, 11, 20, 22, 44, 55, 110, 220

284 - 1, 2, 4, 71, 142, 284

Ramanujan then asked the person to exclude the numbers 220 and 284 and asked the sum of remaining divisors.

220 \rightarrow

$1+2+4+5+10+11+20+22+44+55+110=284$

284 $\rightarrow 1+2+4+71+142=220$

Ramanujan explained that an ideal friendship should be like these numbers which complement each other.

Even when one is absent, the other should represent him.
